Scott is the principal author of the *Standard Practice for Bracing Masonry Walls Under Construction* and the *Internal Bracing Design Guide for Masonry Walls Under Construction*.

He holds B.S. and M.S. degrees in Civil/Structural Engineering from Clemson University (Clemson, SC) as well as a B.S. degree in Architecture from Lawrence Technological University (Southfield, MI). He is registered in multiple states and has analyzed and designed buildings across the country and overseas including many with unusual or creative uses of structural masonry.
